

Wildfire Evacuees

Residents within Northern BC

This is the BC Emergency Alerting System. A wild fire outbreak in Williams Lake and surrounding areas:

1. East of the Fraser River from the existing evacuation order at Soda Creek to 9.0 km south of the Sheep Creek Bridge, including English Road
2. East to the southern end of Chimney Lake, continuing east to Wright Station Road at the north end of Lac La Hache
3. All areas west of Hwy 97 from Wright Station Road to the Williams Lake City limits, north along Hwy 97

If you are a resident of these areas, reply YES for further instruction. If not, reply NO for other options.

This is an Evacuation Order, please evacuate immediately. Follow Hwy 97 South to Hwy 24 (South of 100 Mile House); follow Hwy 24 to Little Fort.

Take emergency survival kit, identifications and medicine — Turn off all water, gas, electricity — Follow evacuation route — Stay calm, everything will be okay!

Once enroute and safely in transit, reply YES for next steps.
